



## Cedrus deodara 'Robusta'



<b>Высота</b>	12 - 15 m
<b>Ширина</b>	10-12m
<b>Крона</b>	broad pyramidal, half-open crown
<b>Кора и ветви</b>	first grey and smooth, later becoming rough
<b>Лист</b>	needles in bundles, dark bluish green, up to 8 cm, evergreen
<b>Цветы</b>	unremarkable, fragrant flowers
<b>Плоды</b>	reddish brown cones, 8 - 12 cm, 1 to 2 together
<b>Колючки/шипы</b>	None
<b>Ядовитость</b>	неядовитый, обычно
<b>Вид почвы</b>	nutrient-rich, well-permeable, acidic soils
<b>Мощение</b>	неустойчив к мощению
<b>Зона зимостойкости</b>	7b (-14,9 до -12,3 °C)
<b>Устойчивость к ветру</b>	moderate
<b>Применение</b>	аллеи и широкие улицы, промышленные зоны
<b>Форма</b>	солитерное хвойное дерево
<b>Происхождение</b>	unknown

This is a cultivar with horizontal lateral branches that are irregularly pendulous at the end. The tree grows out very broadly and develops a broad, pyramidal crown. The crown is more open than those of the species. The needles grow in groups, with up to 30 bundled together. They are dark, bluish green and remarkably longer than those of the species and other cultivars: up to 8 cm. The ovoid, upright cones grow singly or in pairs and have a round top. Saplings are particularly sensitive to frost, requiring a sunny site sheltered from wind. Does not thrive well in high-pH soils.
