



## Acer platanoides 'Globosum'



<b>Высота</b>	5 - 7 м
<b>Ширина</b>	5-7m
<b>Крона</b>	round, later flattened , dark, dense crown
<b>Кора и ветви</b>	bark dark grey, branches light brown
<b>Лист</b>	5/7-lobed, green, circa 18 cm, in autumn golden yellow
<b>Осенний окрас</b>	желтый
<b>Цветы</b>	yellow-green, in corymbs, April, before leaf sprouts
<b>Плоды</b>	winged nutlets (samara), 3.5 - 4.5 cm
<b>Колючки/шипы</b>	None
<b>Ядовитость</b>	ядовитые части
<b>Вид почвы</b>	any soil, except peat
<b>Влажность почвы</b>	устойчив к коротким наводнениям
<b>Мощение</b>	устойчив к мощению
<b>Зона зимостойкости</b>	4 (-34,4 до -28,9 °C)
<b>Устойчивость к ветру</b>	not very sensitive, not resistant to sea wind
<b>Прочие виды устойчивости</b>	устойчив к морозам, зона 1 - 6
<b>Дерево-среда обитания для животных</b>	устойчив к морозам, зона 1 - 6, притягивает бабочек
<b>Применение</b>	кашпо для деревьев, сады на крыше, промышленные зоны, небольшие сады, сады в патио
<b>Форма</b>	штамбовое дерево, многоствольное дерево
<b>Происхождение</b>	Van Houtte, Belgium, 1873

A much used tree with a dense, closed crown. Is grafted on a stem of A. platanoides, usually at 2.2. m high. In the first years the crown is round-headed, when maturing it spreads out, thus assuming a flattened spherical shape. The crown becomes circa 6 m across. When unfurling the leaf has a slightly brown-red hue, later it turns into dark green. In autumn it is intense yellow. The inflorescence is of the species. This tree is less suited for narrow avenues and streets due to its wide crown. 'Globosum' can be applied splendidly on squares and in shopping areas. The cultivar demands little from the soil and is not wind sensitive. Is tolerant to drought.
