



Fagus sylvatica 'Purpurea Pendula'



Высота	3 - 5 m (depending on graft height)
Ширина	6-8m
Крона	broad, weeping, dark, dense crown, capricious growing
Кора и ветви	smooth, grey bark, soft
Лист	oval to ovate, deep reddish brown, 4 - 10 cm long
Цветы	small, inconspicuous flower catkins, May
Плоды	nuts, in cupules covered with brushy spines, 1 - 2 cm
Колючки/шипы	None
Ядовитость	неядовитый, обычно
Вид почвы	well drained, humic soil, not too wet

Fagus sylvatica 'Purpurea Pendula' is slow-growing weeping beech. It does not form a central leader making propagation onto understock at a pre-determined height (e.g. 2.20 m) or nursing on stock of low grafted plants necessary. The main branches grow downwards in an arch, young twigs droop loosely. The deep red-brown leaves are oval to ovate and 4 - 10 cm. It is suitable for smaller gardens when used as a solitary. Requires not too wet, well-drained soil, rich in humus content. Moderate wind resistance. Winter hardiness zone: 6a
