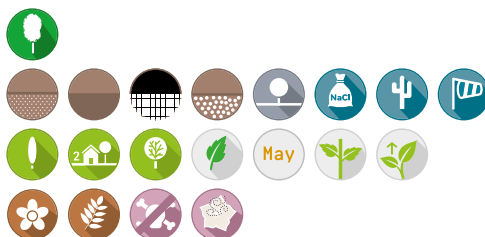




Fraxinus ornus OBELISK ('Paus Johannes Paulus II')

Крона	narrow columnar, later more spreading , half-open crown

Лист	odd-pinnate, 7 - 9 leaflets, dull green, circa 20 - 25 cm , feathered leaf
Цветы	white, in tall erect terminal panicles, May/June, , fragrant flowers

A recent selection that has a columnar shape when juvenile. The main branch grows bolt upright. Later the crown spreads a little. Mature trees have a brown-grey bark which is remarkably smooth and the branches turn from olive green to dull-grey. They have many small lenticels. The large leaf consists of (5) 7 - 9 oblong leaflets that are 5 - 10 cm long. When still young this ash does not flower profusely, however, older trees flower abundantly. 'Obelisk' is one of the most beautiful flowering ashes. The panicles appear after the leaf and they are 10 - 12 cm long and wide. The numerous fruit clusters are ornamental and persist well into winter. The tree is used as street and avenue tree and tolerates hard surfaces well. Prefers drier, calcareous soil.
