Sassafras albidum



Высота	10 - 15 m
Ширина	6-12m
Крона	round, dark, dense crown
Кора и ветви	twigs green, bark brown-grey, deeply grooved
Лист	ovate to elongated, unlobed to 3-lobed, glossy green, 7 - 18 cm
Осенний окрас	желтый, оранжевый
Цветы	in racemose clusters, greenish-yellow, approx. 1.5 cm, April, fragrant flowers
Плоды	ovoid drupe, 1 - 1.5 cm, glossy, dark-blue, on red stem

Striking tree with a dense, round crown of 10 - 15 m. Forms root suckers so a single tree, when mature, can grow into what looks like a thicket. Young twigs are bright green and smooth. The twigs and branches remain green for several years. Old bark is brown-grey with deep, reticulate grooves. The glossy, green leaves are of variable shapes, from unlobed to 3-lobed. The underside is blue-green and slightly to very hairy. The branches as well as the leaves spread an aromatic, lemony fragrance when crushed. In autumn the leaf turns golden yellow to yellow-orange. The flowers appear just before the leaf emerges. Small greenish yellow flowers stand in racemose clusters. They are followed by glossy, darkblue drupes on red stems. Grows on almost every moist to quite dry, well-drained soil. Despite the fact that it is a pioneer tree in its native habitat, S. albidum is difficult to transplant in culture.
