Acer triflorum



Высота	10 m
Ширина	6-8m
Крона	round, half-open crown
Кора и ветви	young twigs yellowish brown, older bark brownish grey, slightly scaling
Лист	trifoliate, green, 3 - 7 cm
Осенний окрас	оранжевый, красный, фиолетовый
Цветы	yellow, in smalls corymbs of three, April/May
Плоды	winged nutlets, 4 - 5 cm long, hairy, 4 - 5 cm
Колючки/шипы	None
Ядовитость	неядовитый, обычно
Вид почвы	neutral to slightly acidic

Bush to large tree, rarely medium-size. Somewhat resembles A. griseum at first sight, but differs from this in (among other things) its browngrey, only slightly scaling bark. With A. griseum, the bark is reddish brown and profusely scaling. The leaves of A. triflorum are hairy and rather more blue-green on the underside. In summer they are green, but in autumn they turn a splendid orange to purplish red. The species name is derived from the fact that each flower corymb comprises only three flowers. A. triflorum should mainly be used as a solitary tree in a garden or park. It prefers a slightly acidic soil.
