Fagus sylvatica 'Miltonensis' is an uncommon medium-sized tree with slightly weeping branches. '*Miltonensis*' can attain a height of 8 - 12 m. When maturing the older branches become more weeping, creating a very spreading crown, and requiring a lot of space. The habit is less regular than of '*Pendula*'. The oval to round leaves are green and turn to brown yellow in autumn. Thrives well in calcareous, but moisture-retentive soil. The soil must be well-drained and rich in humus content. Winter hardiness zone: 5b
