An old, vigorously growing cultivar with a loose crown. At first it is narrow and oval, later becoming somewhat broader. Height 18 - 20 (25) m. The crown has a more regular shape than that of the species and the twigs have few to no thorns. The leaves and flowers are similar to those of the species. 'Semperflorens' blooms much more profusely, however. A less profuse flowering follows every year in August and September. Consequently, it has become popular for use as a park and avenue tree. Its open crown makes the tree reasonably wind-resistant. Winter hardiness zone: 5a
