




# **Robinia pseudoacacia**

## **'Umbraculifera'**



<b>Высота</b>	5 - 6 m
<b>Ширина</b>	4-6m
<b>Крона</b>	round, dark, dense crown
<b>Кора и ветви</b>	twigs olive green to brown, thornless, bark grey-brown, deeply grooved
<b>Лист</b>	odd-pinnate, 15 - 25 cm, 9 - 19 leaf segments, 1 - 4 cm, green, feathered leaf
<b>Цветы</b>	none
<b>Плоды</b>	none, fruitless cultivar
<b>Колючки/шипы</b>	None
<b>Ядовитость</b>	неядовитый, обычно
<b>Вид почвы</b>	few requirements as long as well drained
<b>Влажность почвы</b>	устойчив к сухим почвам
<b>Мощение</b>	устойчив к мощению
<b>Зона зимостойкости</b>	5a (-28,8 до -26,1 °C)
<b>Устойчивость к ветру</b>	moderate
<b>Прочие виды устойчивости</b>	устойчив к морозам, зона 1 - 6, устойчив к соли для улиц
<b>Применение</b>	аллеи и широкие улицы, узкие улицы, промышленные зоны, небольшие сады, сады в патио
<b>Форма</b>	штамбовое дерево, разветвленное дерево
<b>Происхождение</b>	Austria, 1813

Small tree with a spherical crown up to 5-6 m in height and width. Annual pruning keeps the crown compact. If it is not clipped, the tree develops an umbellate crown. Then it can sometimes attain a height of up to 8 m and develop a characteristic manner of growth. '*Umbraculifera*' is always grafted on a stem, at heights between 1.80 m and 2.50 m. The branches do not have any thorns. The green leaves are smaller than those of the species, as are the leaf segments. Leaves out late and keeps its leaves long into the autumn. Does not produce flowers and grows well in light, calcareous soil. Winter hardiness zone: 5a
