Malus toringo 'Scarlett' is a cultivar of the wild ornamental apple species *Malus toringo*, distinguished by its double dark pink flowers. Unlike the single white blossoms of the wild species, 'Scarlett' has striking cascading double flowers in a dark pink hue. This creates a particularly decorative effect in spring. Besides the remarkable flowering, *Malus toringo 'Scarlett'* also produces slightly larger red fruits than the wild species. The compact, upright growth form with dark green shiny leaves is similar, but the double dark pink blooms make 'Scarlett' a significant improvement over the basic genotype. This cultivar of *Malus toringo* is widely used in public green spaces and private gardens because of its ornamental value. Its height of around 4 metres also makes 'Scarlett' suitable for smaller urban gardens. It is a proven, strong selection that is less susceptible to disease than many other ornamental apples. For landscapers and gardeners, *Malus toringo 'Scarlett'* is a recommended variety to enrich the range with a reliable, decorative ornamental apple. Its striking spring blooms are a real asset for public green spaces and private gardens.
